

## **Spring 2024 Auxiliary Projects**

Two times a year in Fall and Spring the Hartford Hospital Auxiliary grants funding to Hartford Hospital Departments for Projects that meet specific requirements that meet the Hospital's values of Integrity, Caring, Excellence, Safety and Equity.

On April 16, 2024 the Auxiliary met and reviewed and granted funding to fifteen projects totaling: \$162,560.

The following are the Approved Projects:

\$34,875 to the Department of Dentistry for the purchase of back office equipment critical to operating the dentistry clinic.

\$28,955 to the Emergency Management Department for training manuals for hazardous materials and decontamination operations.

\$20,990 to the Speech Pathology Department to purchase TIMS the new state of the art recording software. It is used to record/save and review barium swallow studies.

\$14,157 to Preventive Cardiology to purchase two infusion chairs for the Apheresis Clinic and an Exam table.

\$11,980 to the Institute of Living for a Suicide Prevention Program to purchase lockboxes for patients identified as at risk for suicide.

\$10,617 to the Webb Schools to purchase furniture etc. to create welcoming and safe group rooms.

\$10,312 to the Barney Fitness Center for the purchase of new fitness equipment-Cable Crossover Machine.

\$7,830 to the Emergency Department Observation Unit for 15 privacy screens for patients in hallways and fifty reusable pulse oximeter sensors.

\$6,572 to CB2/Oncology Unit to purchase three vital signs machines that have the ability to take blood pressure, pulse, oxygen saturation and temperature.

\$4,385 to the Inpatient Rehabilitation Unit to purchase a prism adaptation therapy kit to use post stroke.

\$3,585 to Women's Ambulatory Health Services to purchase three LEEP simulation trainers.

\$2,136 to the Institute of Living to purchase a Sara Steady for the inpatient geriatric unit which addresses a safer environment for patients and staff when mobilizing patients that requires more than one person.

\$2,100 to the Institute of Living Psychology Department to purchase HappyLight LED Therapy Lights.

\$2,039 to Ambulatory Surgery to purchase anti fatigue mats for staff.

\$2,026 to Adult Primary Care/Diabetes Life Care for Continuous Glucose Monitors.
